### Awareness program on 'Intellectual Property Rights' organized by Department of Chemistry, University PG College, Palamuru University

#### Under NIPAM, DPIIT, Govt. Of India,

Department of Chemistry, University PG College, Palamuru University in association with the office of Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India organized an informative awareness program on titled "IPR Awareness Programme" for the faculty members and students under National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission (NIPAM). Dr. D. Ayodhya, Examiner of Patents and Designs, DPIIT, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, was the resource person. The program was attended by 250 participants both from students (220) and Faculty from various departments (30). Dr. D. Ayodhya highlighted the importance of Intellectual Property as the foundation of creativity, innovation and research. He presented the classification of IPRs including patents, copyrights, trademarks, industrial designs, and geographical indications and gave insights on various aspects of registering them with good examples. He mentioned endless examples of patents that are currently being used in different sectors right from agriculture to the high-end industries. He also gave brief information about filing a patent and the various process involved in it till the award of patent, he also emphasized upon the advantages of protecting IPRs. He concluded by suggesting the participants to take maximum benefit of the Intellectual Property Rights.

The programme was organized by Prof. K. Girija Mangatayaru, BoS, Chairperson and Dr. M. Noorjahan, Principal of University PG College and Coconvenors as Dr. N. Chandra Kiran and Dr. S. Vijaya lakshmi, department of Chemistry. The Honorable Vice Chancellor of Palamuru University, Prof. Laxmikanth Rathod emphasized the need of putting together a programme that not only familiarizes students with intellectual property rights but also provides them with extensive information about their value (IPR). He also acknowledged the critical role of IPR in enhancing the nation's socioeconomic expansion and, as a result, contributing to the Atmanirbhar Bharat campaign. He saw this event as a step forward in collaboration with the Indian government in focusing on innovation and start-ups. He asserted that the time has arrived for the youth to make the jump into hard work, not as an employee but as an employer. Prof. P. Pavan Kumar, Registrar, PU, and Dr. D. Madhusudhan Reddy, Director IQAC &OSD to VC, shared their views about importance of such programs for students and Faculty in the HEIs.
