3.1 Promotion of Research and Facilities

3.1.1

Response:

Palamuru University is in the process of augmenting and upgrading research facilities. Central Research facility is envisaged to evolve an ecosystem for creation and dissemination of knowledge and to facilitate campus wide interdisciplinary research pursuits on a coordinated basis. This integrated facility to be housed in a spacious building comprising high-end laboratories, state-of-the-art equipment, sophisticated instrumentation, testing and analytical services will give big boost to sponsored research and consultancy.

There is impetus for this development in view of introduction of Doctoral Programmes in more number of Subjects and sanction of funding from RUSA in the post accreditation phase for enhancement of research facilities. Promotion of Research is also envisaged as a vehicle for enhancing Industry-Institute interaction.

The University has formulated Research Policy in furtherance of advancement of knowledge. This helps the University to coordinate the research pursuits by individual faculty and set norms for undertaking sponsored research in the form of research projects from National Funding Agencies and through Industry and International Collaborations. Research Policy lays emphasis on generation and promotion of intellectual capital through patents and IPR. The Policy seeks to check the menace of misconduct and Plagiarism in research and give impetus to ethical academic publishing. This way, Research Policy also provides guidance to the Faculty, Research Scholars and Students in good academic research practices.

Research Policy of the University is uploaded on the Website. Research Advisory Committee (RAC) has been constituted for effective implementation of University Research Agenda. In pursuance of Research Policy, the University has taken up the preparation of action plan for research admissions during the academic session 2021-22. In the wake of this, necessary preparations have been envisaged for hybrid mode of conduct of Ph.D. admissions.

The action plan has helped the University administration as a guide to action in this specific situation. The University seeks to foster a research culture that is more accessible, transparent and reproducible.

The University is registered with UGC-INFLIBNET for compliance with Shodh Ganga, (for uploading Doctoral dissertations) Shodh Gangotri (for uploading Doctoral research proposals) and Shodh Shudhi (for availing antiplagiarism software to ensure academic integrity).

3.3 Innovation Ecosystem

3.3.1

Institution has created an ecosystem for innovations, Indian Knowledge System (IKS),including awareness about IPR, establishment of IPR cell, Incubation centre and other initiatives for the creation and transfer of knowledge/technology and the outcomes of the same are evident

Response:

Palamuru University is stepping up efforts to give shape to its research portfolio and evolve an ecosystem for creation and transfer of knowledge in furtherance of its mission. The University is actively pursuing the setting up of incubation centre on the campus for channelling entrepreneurial initiatives and promoting start-ups to cater to wider opportunities, with the support of the neighbouring Pharma Industry. As a part of this, university has approached Pharma majors such as MSN Labs and Hetero Labs, Hyderabad for handholding.

The University is giving impetus for creation and transfer of knowledge. The faculty are involved in the preparation of educational videos in different subjects for uploading on YouTube and other Educational Channels for wider dissemination of knowledge. Department of Telugu is extending support for content creation in Indian Languages (Telugu). Department of English is associated with the organization of a unique exhibition for popularization of extinct traditional folk music instruments (Moola Dhwani) in collaboration with University of Hyderabad and Osmania University.

Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Cell has been established for orienting the faculty regarding technological innovations, IPR and filing of patents. This Cell has been organizing awareness programmes in collaboration with Department of Science & Technology Govt. of India and Telangana State Council of Science & Technology. Four such programmes have been conducted on 10-03-2022, 21-03-2023, 14-09-2023, 30-03-2024. A beginning has been made in this direction and the University has successfully filed one patent.

University Industry Cell has also been established to forge research collaboration with Industry, NGOs, and Research Institutions and facilitate student internships, project placement and job prospects. MoUs have been concluded with Institute of Cost and Works Accountants - ICWA (09-09-2021) Institute of Company Secretaries of India - ICSI, and Telangana Academy of Skill & Knowledge – TASK.

Consultancy portfolio is given concrete shape through establishment of Consultancy Cell. It facilitates sharing and transfer of faculty expertise towards augmentation of University revenue and resources. Consultancy Policy has been formulated as a guide to action and for promotion of industry-Institution interaction. Faculty are encouraged to take up consultancy projects in furtherance of this objective. Consultancy policy is uploaded on the university Web site.

3.6.1

Response:

Extension and outreach activities are the vehicle for Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR). Palamuru University has accorded due priority to this third dimension of higher education. The University is in

forefront in taking up a number of initiatives in this direction through curricular interventions as well as through NSS programmes.

The University has been successful in sensitizing the students to societal concerns and instilling in them a sense of purpose and social responsibility to contribute to the community well-being through these structured avenues.

There is active involvement of students as well as faculty across all the academic programmes of the University in these Nation building pursuits. Curricular requirements are harmoniously incorporated into NSS special camps organised from time to time wherein there is provision for multi departmental involvement and collaboration.

These have facilitated rendering of value-based services to the local population including urban community and provided opportunities for addressing the specific societal concerns such as cleanliness (through **Swachh Bharath Abhiyan**), Greenery (through **Tree Plantation**) Electoral Participation (through **Voter Awareness Programmes**), Livelihood Promotion (facilitating distribution of **Cycles & Sewing Machines**), Health Promotion (through **Blood Donation Camps**, and facilitating **Free Distribution of Medicines**), and awareness campaign on other social issues. The concern and commitment of the students and their contribution to community reconstruction has been demonstrated in ample terms through the said extension & outreach interventions.

- Specific mention needs to be made to the active involvement of NSS in conducting Voter Awareness Programmes under the auspices of SVEEP, Mahabubnagar for the wider outreach (inclusivity of Transgenders and Senior Citizens) on 21-09-2018, 17-11-2018, and during April 2024.
- NSS of Palamuru University has also been in fore front in giving a big push to Swachatha Abhiyan through massive cleaning programmes at public places in Mahabubnagar on 14 -2-2022 and 24-11-2023.
- NSS has been facilitating Women Empowerment and Livelihood Promotion through distribution of Cycles and Sewing Machines to the needy women with handholding from Rotary Global Championship and Rotary Club of North Hyderabad on 17-09-2022.
- NSS has demonstrated its deep social commitment through the unique interventions of conduct of Mega Medical Health Camps at Bourapur Village on 04-08-2021, Zamistanpur village on 07-04-2022 including Blood Donation Camp at the Campus with support from Indian Red Cross Society, Mahabubnagar on 01-10-2021.

Extension initiatives have opened up a new window of service learning through community engagement for the students. The immersive learning experience in real world settings amid addressing live concerns has substantially contributed to broadening of perspectives, personality development, value orientation and inculcation of research culture among the students. The synergy of such participation has been valuable for the university.

NSS has been the backbone in the initiation and sustenance of the flagship programme of One Lakh Tree Plantation at the main Campus for which the University is conferred with **ONE DISTRICT ONE GREEN CHAMPION** Award.

This way, the University has been able to create positive impact and gain respectability and visibility among the neighbouring communities and villages including Palamuru Town through such purposeful

NSS interventions.
