Efforts taken by the institution to provide career counselling including e-counselling and guidance for competitive examinations during the last five years

Response:

Palamuru University is striving for student empowerment and employability through career orientation skill building and structured coaching. Placement assistance and guidance for competitive examinations are also taken up with passion at the University. The services of University Study Circle, CELT and Central Placement Cell are actively enlisted in these efforts.

Palamuru University has undertaken intensive coaching Programs for competitive examinations through PU Study Circle with impetus from the Telangana State Council of Higher Education. It is the first University in the state to take lead in this regard and start the competitive examination coaching programmes in October 2021.

The free coaching programme schedule comprised coaching camps for Group I/II/III/IV Examinations conducted by State Public Service Commission, Teacher Eligibility Test (TET), and for police recruitment (SI & police constable) conducted by State Police Recruitment Board.

Nearly 150 candidates have enrolled for coaching programme in Group I&II services, out of which about 70 students have qualified.

Free coaching for TET has commenced on 27-04-2022. Large number of students have availed the facility for TET coaching. Study material and relevant books for the examination have been distributed to the registered students on 06-05-2022.

Nearly 100 candidates have enrolled in coaching programme for Police recruitment and up to 80 have qualified. Presently, training for physical fitness is being imparted to the written test qualified police recruitment candidates in coordination with the Physical Education Department. This programme is coming in handy for improving the performance of candidates in various physical tests required for S.I. and Police Constables recruitment.

CELT (Centre for English Language Training) has been envisaged as a central facility for capacity enhancement and skill building among the student community. It has been conducting certificate programmes on English Language and Communication Skills on a regular basis for the students of campus and affiliated colleges.

The University has its proactive Placement Cell which conducts training programmes for the career preparedness of the students including promotion of employability skills. It also invites companies for conducting Pre-Placement Talks, Job Melas and recruitment drives. In this connection, an institutional arrangement with agencies like RUBICON and FULL STACK ACADEMY for Pre-Placement Talks on Soft Skills enhancements is being availed for the benefit of M.Com. & MBA and MCA & M.Sc. Computer Science students on regular basis. In pursuance of the MoU with TASK both online and offline career counselling sessions have been conducted for the benefit of students from Pharmacy, Science, Management and Computer Science streams.

Formation of Alumni networks initiated by it in different parts of the state is also in progress.

Another alumni body of Pharmacy students, formally registered as Palamuru University Pharmacy Alumni Association is equally active. It is in forefront in enlisting the support of Alumni and pharma industry for institutional development.

Both Alumni bodies are ahead in arranging Alumni visits to the campus and motivational talks by them to the students. They have chalked out action plans for institution of endowment lectures, and sponsorship of scholarships/ book grants for needy students.

Alumni contribution to the university is forthcoming in the academic domain too through eliciting feedback & suggestions on curriculum, pedagogy and courses as well as enlisting their services as Guest faculty and when required.

The University has joined Chancellor Connects Alumni initiative conceived by Hon'ble Governor and Chancellor during 2020. So far 300 Alumni have registered in this integrated portal.
