BRIEF PROFILE OF PALAMURU UNIVERSITY

Palamuru University has been established in the year 2008 by an Act of State Legislature to cater to the growing requirements of Higher Education of the region in general and of Mahabubnagar district in particular. The University started functioning from the academic year 2008-09 with the then PG College of Osmania University at Mahabubnagar as the nucleus. Since then it has been Progressing well and fast emerging as a new destination of higher learning. Palamuru University offers (17) PG courses and Ph.D. programs in nine disciplines at its main campus and three PG centers put together. There are more than 2000 students on rolls in the main campus. Palamuru University has been accredited with Grade 'B' by NAAC in November, 2018.

About PG Centre Kollapur : Post Graduate Centre, Kollapur was established by Palamuru University Mahabubnagar, had started its Operations from academic year 2014-15 with three departments MBA, MSc (Mathematics) and MA (English) and added with another three departments M.COM, MA(Telugu) and MSW(Social Work) in the Academic year 2015-16. PG Centre is just 2 Km away from Kollapur Bus stand, i.e., Kollapur - Hyderabad main road easily reachable. Establishment of PG centre in this Remote area had definitely helped the students to study higher education by staying at their home places. Mahatma Gandhi National Council Rural Education , Ministry of Education GOI, has recognized Model College in Nagarkurnool district and also got Green Champion award from MGNCRE.

Department Profile: The Department of Social Work was established in 2015 under the Palamuru University at Kollapur P.G. Centre with four semesters with 40 intake seats and offering Master of social work (MSW) for the benefit of student community and region. The department since its inception strived for academic excellence and incredible field experience in creating and contributing to academic and issue based ambience for the students. Students are empowered with auxiliary knowledge of field work experience. The curriculum of course covers various rural development and field experience to the students. The students are also trained in community participation and social activities. The Department of Social Work has four faculty members having UGC-NET, SLET and pursuing PhD's in various universities. It also provides two specializations for the students and with an intake of 60 seats.

About Earth Saviour Foundation: Internationally Recognized NGO - Committed To Serving Humanity: Since 2008, our NGO has been running an old age home and a rescue centre. Our Founder, Late Karmayogi Shri Ravi Kalra ji started the missions of the Organization by himself going on the roads and rescuing less privileged people. He personally built a small hut on an empty plot of land and gave shelter to every abandoned person that he could rescue from the roads. Now, Sh. Jas Kalra, his son, runs the organisation under his able leadership as President. Today, around 1000 less privileged people are living permanently in our NGO's shelter homes located at Bandhwari Village and Mandawar Village, Dist. Gurugram, Haryana. Those that live in our shelter homes are abandoned senior citizens, homeless mentally disabled people, deprived females, burnt victims, victims of domestic violence, rape victims, physically injured, people suffering from incurable diseases such as HIV, schizophrenia etc. People that reside in our Gurukuls are between the ages of 18 and 100 years. These people are brought to our NGO's shelter homes by the police, Govt. Hospitals, referred by Hon'ble courts and by social welfare departments. By the grace of God, all the facilities at our NGO are completely free of charges for the less privileged people such as accommodation, food, medical aid and every day amenities

Kollapur at a glance: Kollapur region is an area spanning the Nallamala Forest area on the banks of the river Krishna in the Nagarkurnool district, in the state of Telangana India. The Someswara, Sangameswara, and Malleswara temples are in this region, with traces of architectural treasures from the 2nd century BC. Hundreds of ancient temples are visible in the area, mainly built over 1,500 years ago. Due to similar broad roads and surrounding tree plantations, people used to refer to Kollapur as Telangana Mysore (a reference to the larger city of Mysore). In the year 2030 launching of 250 acres of biological research institute at this areas with an estimated value of the project is about 2000cr Indian currency. Tourism was developed at Somashila in Kollapur to be an ecotourism destination together with Jataprolu and Singotam and there are 10 cottages, hotel Haritha and
